UNIT 3: Desirable skills and attitudes – **WHEEL OF SKILLS**

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The aim of this exercise is to help participants to understand what skills are useful in developing their financial satisfaction from running vocational activities in CCI's and to help them to think how they would rate themselves on their confidence level in this skills currently.

At first step mentor gives to each participant the list of the desirable skills/attitudes asking them to choose 8 – most in important in their opinion in running business in cultural and creative sector and rank them in the context of the level of their self-confident (from 0 to 5: “0” means “not confident” and “5” - extremely confident).

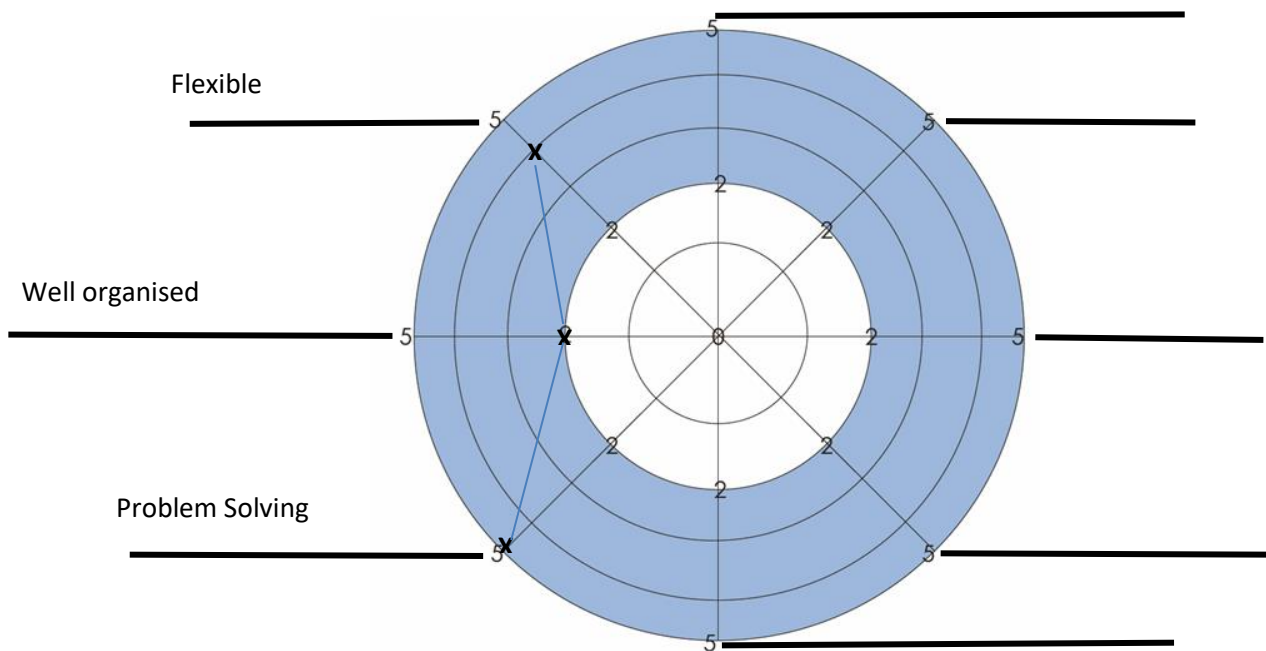
After this mentor ask them to write down these 8 chosen skills/attitudes at the end of the lines at the wheel. Then the participants should put an X on the score for each of the 8 skills/attitudes and then join up all the Xs.

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List of desirable skills/attitudes:

4	Flexible

	Good communication skills
	Creative thinking

5	Problem Solving



A general group discussion following the exercise helps participants to see ways they could increase confidence in their skills where necessary or to see what skills they have confidence in currently to use these to their best effect.

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
