

WHAT IS THIS TOUR ABOUT? DANS(E) LES RUES




The participants of the tour, led by a **guide**, will **dance to the rythm** of a **collaborative music playlist** around notable spots of the city.










CITY TOUR LEADER

A city explorer is in charge of animating the group, the route of the tour and the music streaming.

The need for someone from the CCIs or tourism industry to lead the activity presents an opportunity to engage with the local arts arts industry.

The tour's length will depend on how the group reacts to the dynamics of the activity, but 2h would be a good duration.



USE OF DIGITAL TOOLS SILENT DISCO

The innovation of this tour lies on its **simplicity** and **replicability** in other cities due to the ease and small number of **digital tools** that are needed:

- **PHONE WITH INTERNET** Spotify is a streaming app that requires Internet connection.
- SPOTIFY PLAYLIST Easibly accessible through a QR code. Collaborative playlist of Belgian music.
- ONLINE CITY MAP Map of Mons in which new spots can be added by participants.
- PAIR OF HEADPHONES Each participant will use their own headphones, therefore there is not any noise disturbance to the others.





SUSTAINABILITY STREET HARMONY

This tour's features make this project sustainable because they are:

- SOCIALLY SUSTAINABLE As it does not entail the typical tourist format of a tour, it might get the attention and engage with the locals, bringing together locals, tourists and even foreigners. The collaborative aspect of the playlist and map contribute to the better understanding and connection among citizens.
- ECONOMICALLY SUSTAINABLE Since all the resources are available online and for free. The only thing that could incur a cost would be the engagement of a city explorer to guide the tour, which would still positively impact the local art industry if the chosen person was a member of the CCIs.
- ENVIRONMENTALLY SUSTAINABLE The nature of this tour is essentially 100% environmentally sustainable, including the element of the headphones that do not contribute to noise pollution.
- TIME-EFFICIENT SUSTAINABILITY• The simplicity of the proposal of this tour makes it replicable and likely to continue being enhanced in the future.
